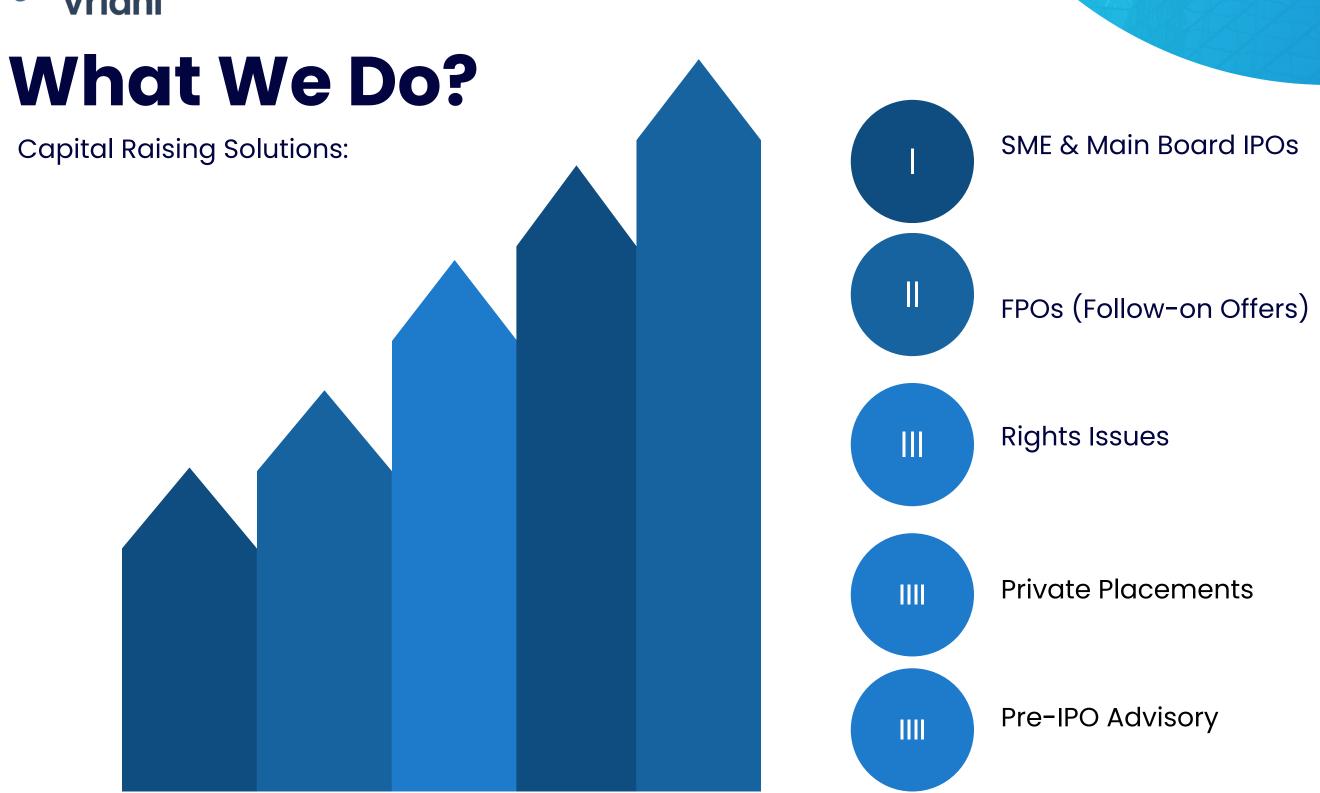

Profit Track Record	1–2 yrs (flexible)	3 yrs mandatory
Market Cap	₹ 10-25 Cr	₹100+ Cr
No. of Investors (Post IPO)	50+	1,000+
Reporting Compliance	Half-Yearly	1,000+



SME Listing Eligibility Criteria

NSE Emerge and BSE SME Requirements

- Minimum Net Tangible Assets ₹1.5-2 Crore
- Net Worth: ₹1-3 Crore
- Positive Net Profit: Achieved in 2 of the last 3 years
- Years in Existence: At least 3 years
- Post-Issue Paid-up Capital: ₹1-25 Crore
- Minimum Shareholders: 50
- Promoter Stake: Must maintain a majority stake post-IPO

IPO Listing Process

Assess IPO feasibility

Evaluate the viability of an IPO

Legal & financial due diligence

Conduct thorough legal and financial checks

Convert to Public Ltd Company

Transform into a public limited company

File Draft Prospectus (DRHP)

Submit the draft prospectus to authorities

Marketing/pricing

Promote and price the IPO shares

Listing

List the company's shares on the stock exchange

























Appoint Merchant Banker

Hire a SEBIregistered financial advisor

Restructure business/capital

Reorganize business and capital structure

Appoint intermediaries

Engage necessary intermediaries for the IPO

Obtain Exchange & ROC approvals

Secure approvals from stock exchanges and ROC

Launch IPO

Officially launch the IPO to the public

Post-listing compliance

Ensure compliance with regulations after listing



IPO Journey Roadmap (Timeline)

Phase	Duration	Key Activities
Pre-IPO Preparation	4-8 weeks	Assessment, Intermediaries, Due diligence
Documentation & Approval	6-10 weeks	DRHP, Exchange Filing, Approvals
Marketing & Roadshows	2-3 weeks	Investor meets, Pricing, Prospectus
Public Issue	1 week	Subscription, Application collection
Post-Issue & Listing	2-3 weeks	Allotment, Listing, Trading

FAQ's & Commen concerns



What are the costs involved?

Typically 8-12% of issue size including merchant banker fees, compliance costs, marketing expenses, and regulatory fees

How much promoter dilution is required?

Minimum 25% public shareholding required, but promoters can retain majority control

How long does the process take?

4-6 months from appointment of merchant banker to listing on exchange

6 Is there guaranteed investor interest?

100% underwriting ensures IPO success, with market maker providing liquidity for 3 years
